The OBE Programme explores and makes use of the potentialities of Distance Education Mode (DEM) for reaching the unreached. There is a provision of separate OBE programme for children and adults. Some significant highlights of OBE programme are as follows: Boards.

The OBE Programme is offered at three levels:

OBE level A : equivalent to class I-III
OBE level B : equivalent to class IV-V
OBE level C : equivalent to class VI-VIII
